

REACH Policy Statement

2025



This statement is made by Trent Instruments Ltd with regards to REACH & RoHS Provisions.

It is the Companies understanding that there are currently no REACH or RoHS requirements that apply to Trent Instruments Ltd products.

As supplied, there are no substances intended to be released from Trent Instruments Ltd products under normal or reasonably foreseeable conditions of use. Therefore, the requirement in REACH article 7 (1) (b) to register substances contained in articles does not apply.

Trent Instruments Ltd do not use any Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC) that are on the current European Chemical Agency's (ECHA) Candidate list in the manufacture of its products. Therefore, the requirements in REACH article 7 (2) to notify ECHA if an article contains > 0.1 mass % of an SVCH and tonnage exceeds 1 tonne per importer per year is not applicable to Trent Instruments Ltd.

Trent Instruments Ltd does not manufacture or import chemicals. As a downstream user Trent Instruments Ltd has no obligation to register substances used in their operations and products.

The board has overall responsibility for this policy and for ensuring compliance with law. The Managing Director has overall responsibility for the day-to-day operational responsibility for this policy.

This policy statement will be reviewed annually unless circumstances dictate it should be reviewed more frequently. The last review of this policy was on **30.07.2025**.
